Presentation Marshalling	All riders are to present for gear check prior to reporting to the appropriate marshaller in the warm up area well before their estimated riding time. Riders who have not completed their C Certificate must report to gear check with a parent, DC or Club representative. The dressage marshaller will call riders for their test as appropriate. Riders must be prepared to ride early if there are scratchings in their ring.
